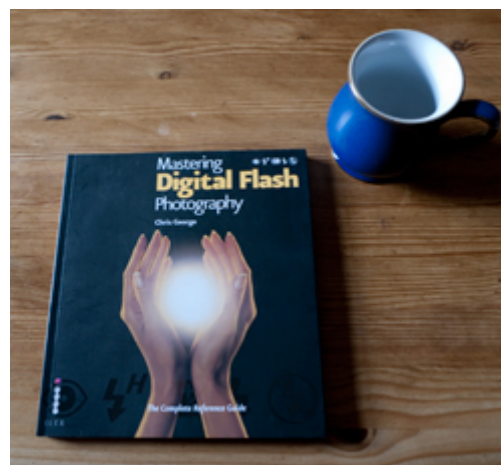

Each chapter is then sub-divided into 'chunks' of information so it is easily digestible and hence the book can be dipped-into whenever required. There are numerous comparison shots that show why a particular set-up works and various explanatory diagrams to show how individual shots were lit.
